

## Shore Angling Map

### Bantry Bay and Beara Peninsula

1. FOILATHUGGIG: Bottom fishing for conger, spinning for pollack and float fishing for wrasse.
2. ESKAPHREAGHAUN: Spinning for pollack and float fishing for wrasse.
3. KILCATHERINE POINT: Spinning for pollack and float fishing for wrasse. High water best.
4. BALLYDONEGAN STRAND: Bottom fishing for bass and flat fish on sandy beach at mouth of stream. Bottom fishing from pier for dogfish and flatfish. Lugworm and crab best.
5. DURSEY ROCKS: Good wrasse fishing on north western side of cable car also spinning for pollack and mackerel.
6. DURSEY SOUND: Float and bottom fishing for wrasse and spinning for pollack.
7. MATTHEWS ROCKS: Spinning for pollack and float fishing for wrasse. Bottom fishing for conger.
8. PIPERS ROCKS. Park your car near the end of track and walk half a mile down to point opposite lighthouse on Bear Island. Float and bottom fishing for wrasse. Spinning for mackerel and pollack. Deep water towards the channel.
9. CASTLETOWNBERE HARBOUR: Bottom fishing for conger from the pier. Float fishing for mullet using small pieces of fish offal.
10. D.O.D PIER: Bottom fishing for thornback ray and dogfish. Float fishing for mullet, ground baiting is essential.
11. COARRID POINT: Bottom fishing for ray, dogfish, conger and three bearded rockling. Fish bait best.
12. BANK HARBOUR: Bottom fishing for flatfish on flooding tide. Floatfish for mullet at high water.
13. SHOT HEAD: Spinning for mackerel and pollack and float fishing for wrasse.
14. ZETLAND PIER: Bottom fishing for flatfish and dogfish on sandy patches and in channel. Parking on pier.
15. COOMHOLA ESTUARY: Bottom fishing on late flood and high water for flounder. Soft or peeler crab best.
16. REENYDONAGAN LAKE: Bottom fishing at mouth of lake for dogfish and flounder and some thornback ray. Late flood and high water best.
17. BANTRY PIER: Bottom fishing for conger and dogfish. Night-time best for conger and the pier has a light.
18. BEACH STRAND: Clean steep to beach beside airstrip. Excellent bottom fishing for thornback ray, dogfish, flatfish and occasional bull huss. Razor fish at low water springs. Approach this beach from airstrip.
19. GERAHIES PIER: Float fishing for mullet and ground baiting is essential. Bottom fishing for conger and night-time best. There is a light on the pier.
20. GOATS PATH: Spinning for mackerel and pollack and float fishing for wrasse.
21. COLLACK: Float fishing for wrasse. Good wrasse taken from here, also spinning for pollack.
22. GLANROON: Float fishing for wrasse within the confines of the cove. Spinning for pollack and mackerel and float fishing for wrasse on seaward side of cove.
23. THE COVE: Spinning for mackerel and pollack, also float fishing for wrasse.
24. FOILBEG: Float fish for wrasse and spinning for pollack and mackerel.
25. CAHEER PIER: Bottom fishing for conger and dogfish and occasional bull huss.

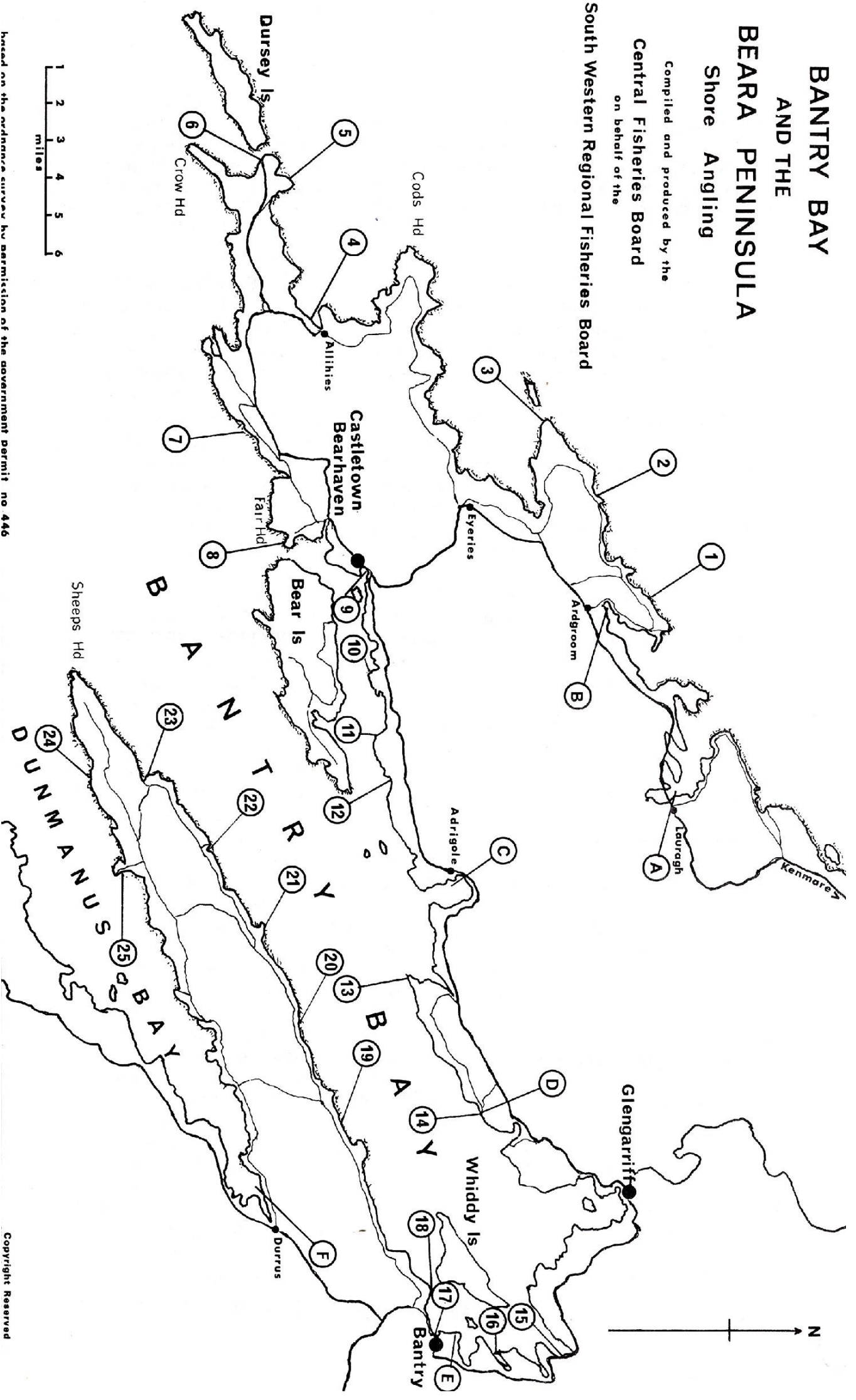
### BAIT

- A. LAURAGH: Lugworm.
- B. ARDGROOM: Lugworm in sandy patches. Soft and peeler crab under weed near pier.
- C. ADRIGOLE: Lugworm can be dug on middle banks, also in the mud inshore mussel beds.
- D. ZETLAND PIER: Lugworm and sme peeler crab. Razor fish at low water springs.
- E. COBH STRAND: Lugworm, mussel and some clams.
- F. DURRUS: Lugworm in mud. Soft patches in mud. Peeler crab under weed 1 mile from village.
